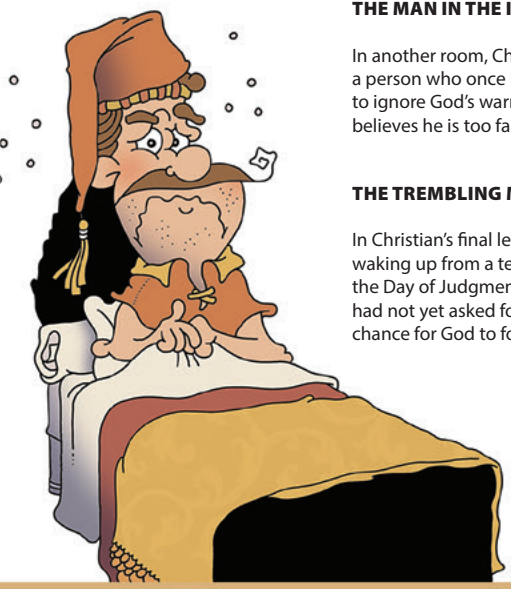

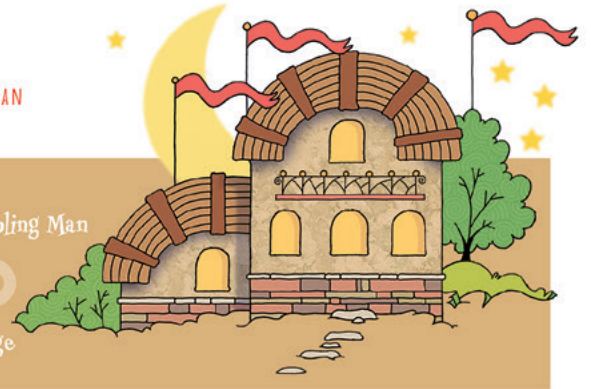

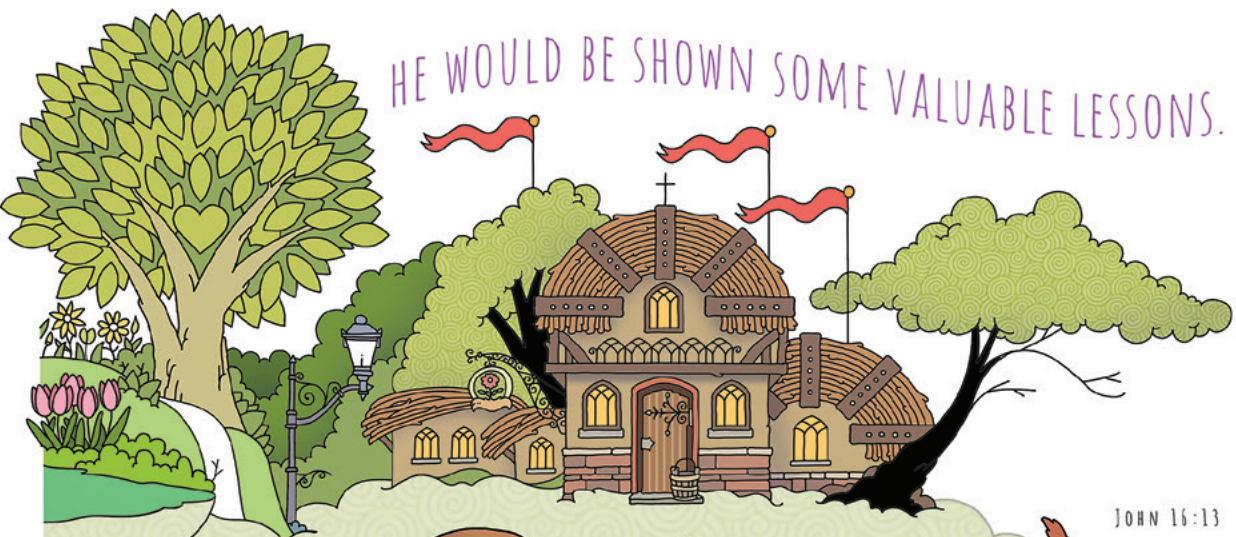


## YOU ARE HERE

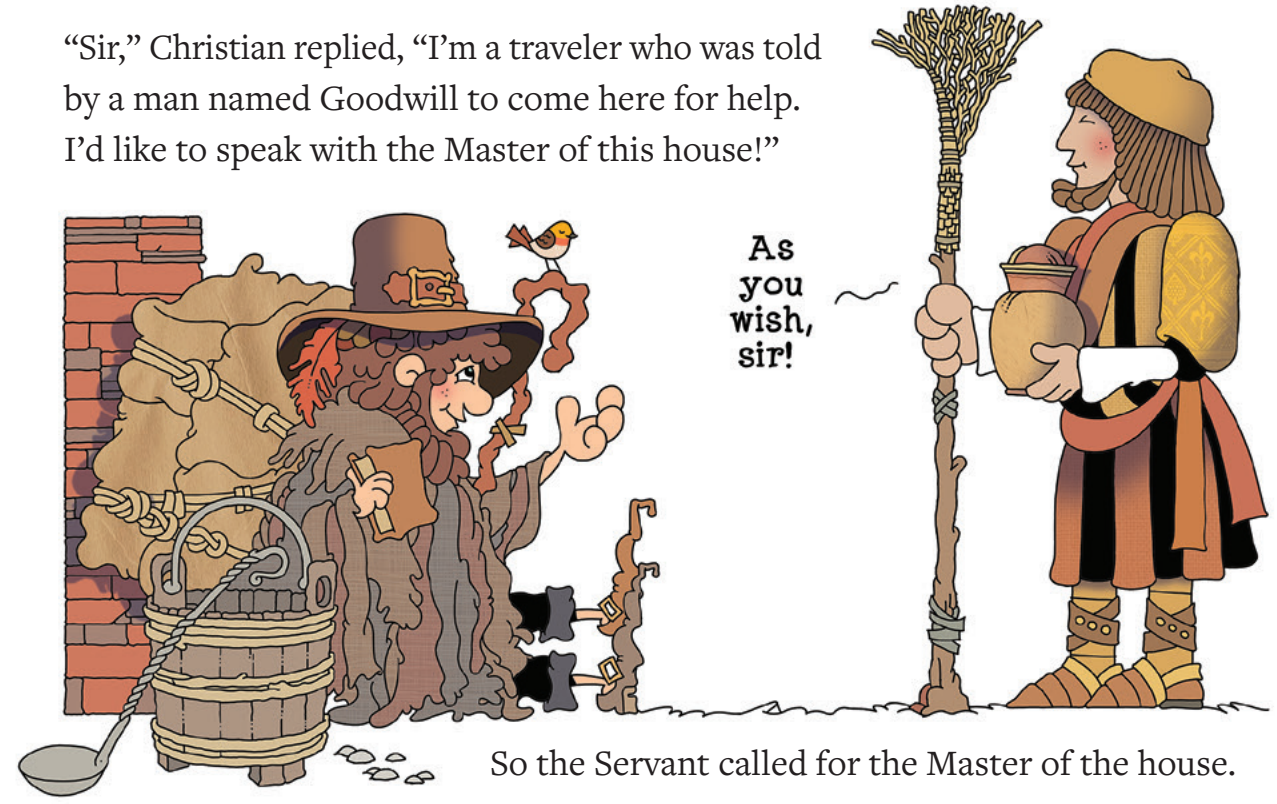

So Christian traveled on until he came to that house, where he knocked again and again and again. At last someone came to the door and asked who was there.



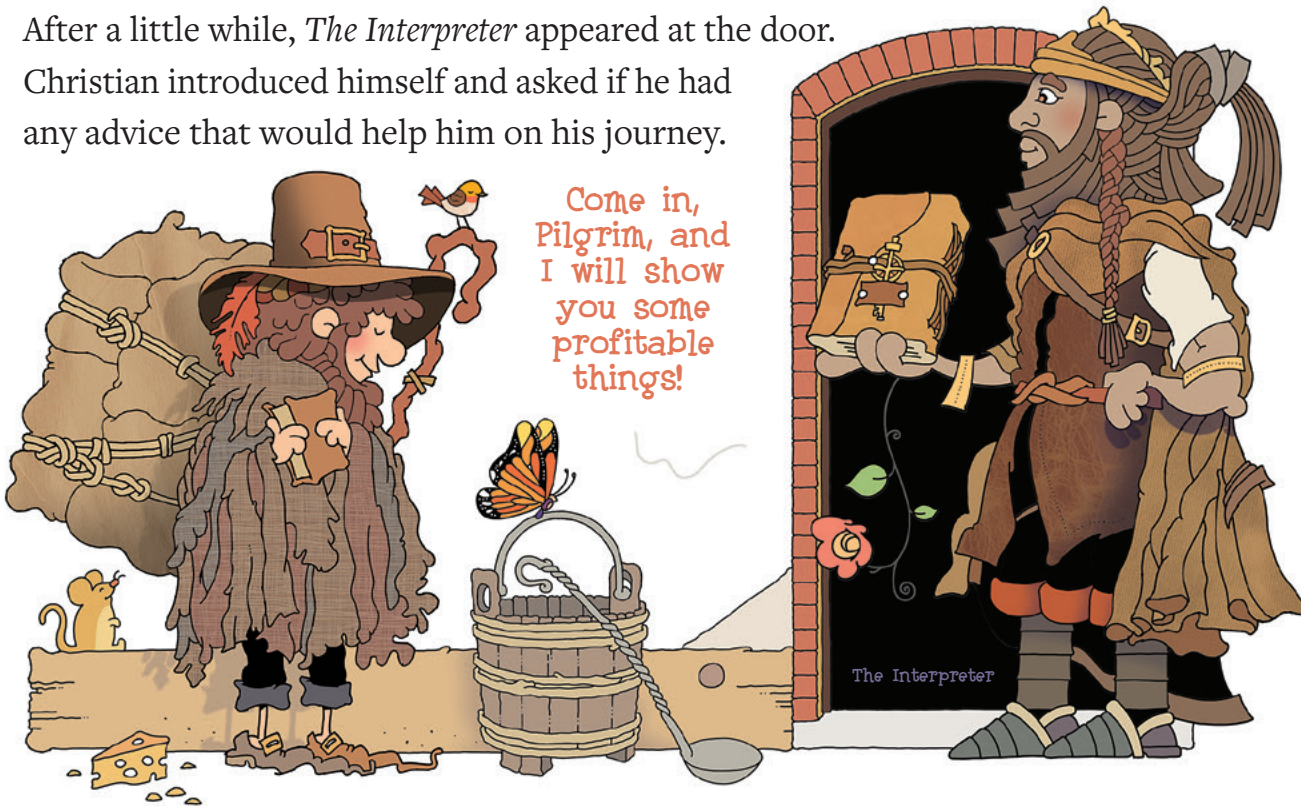
“Sir,” Christian replied, “I’m a traveler who was told by a man named Goodwill to come here for help. I’d like to speak with the Master of this house!”

After a little while, *The Interpreter* appeared at the door. Christian introduced himself and asked if he had any advice that would help him on his journey.

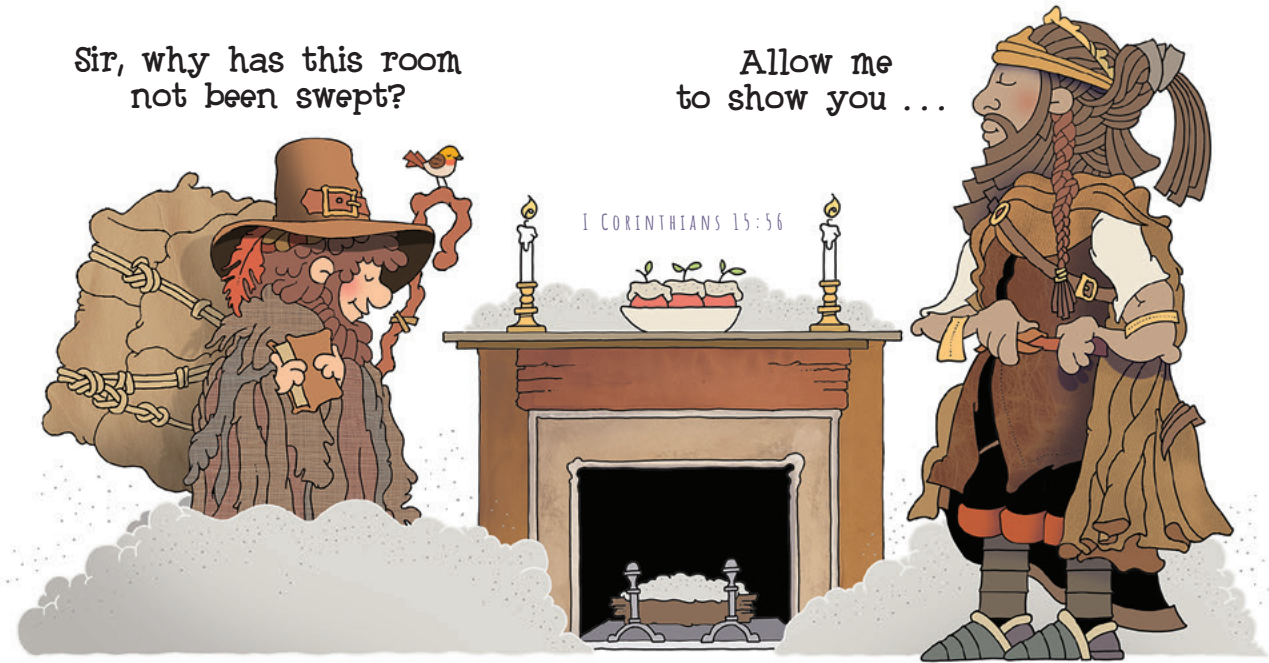


Come in, Pilgrim, and I will show you some profitable things!
