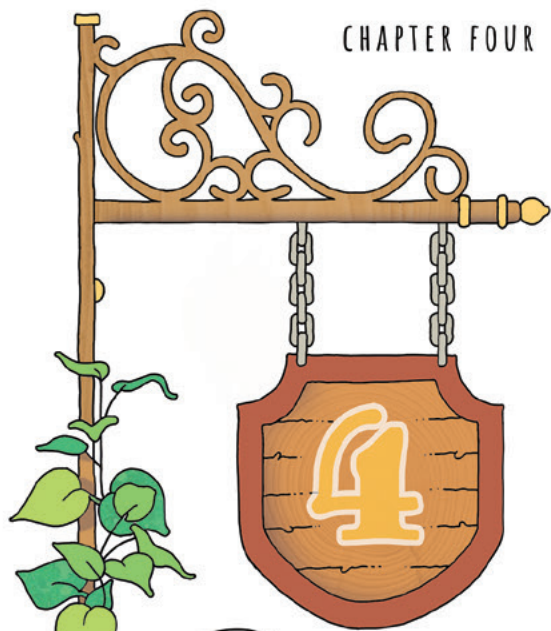

They become his guides and guardians, providing him with wisdom, knowledge, resources, and godly correction during his journey to the Celestial City.

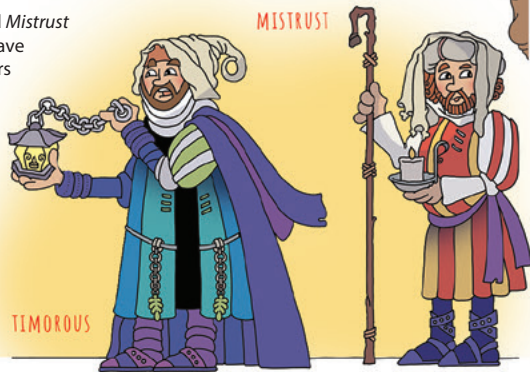

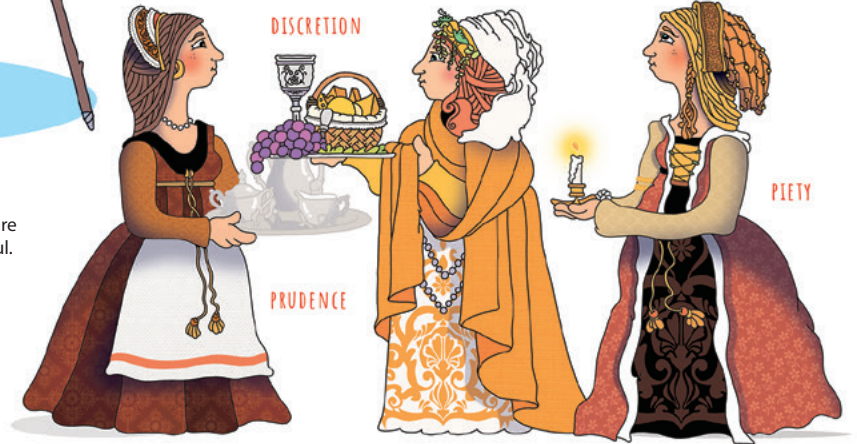

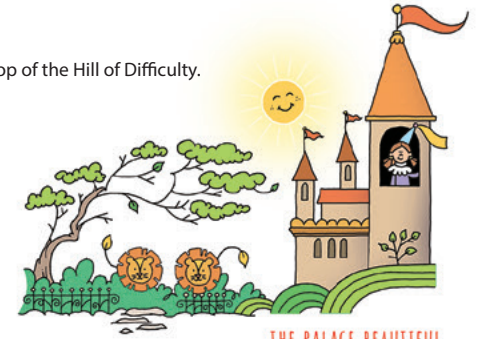

### THE PALACE BEAUTIFUL

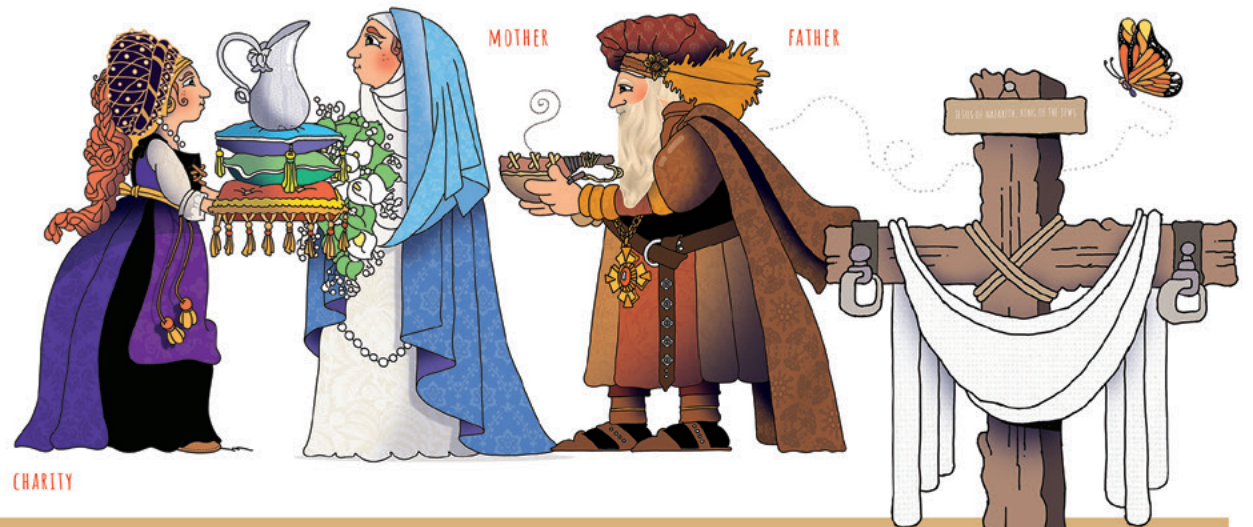
The *Palace Beautiful* is at the top of the Hill of Difficulty.

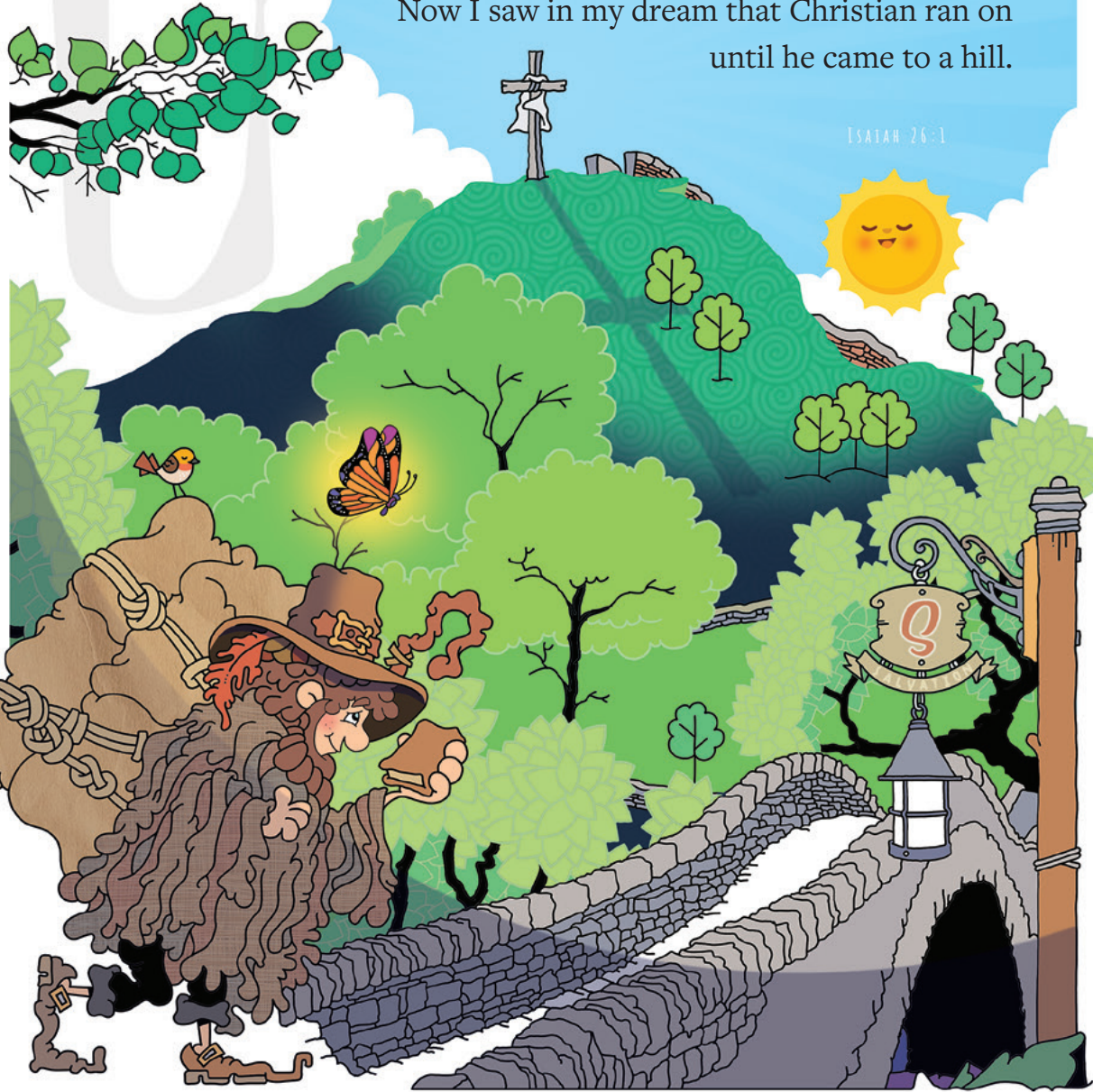

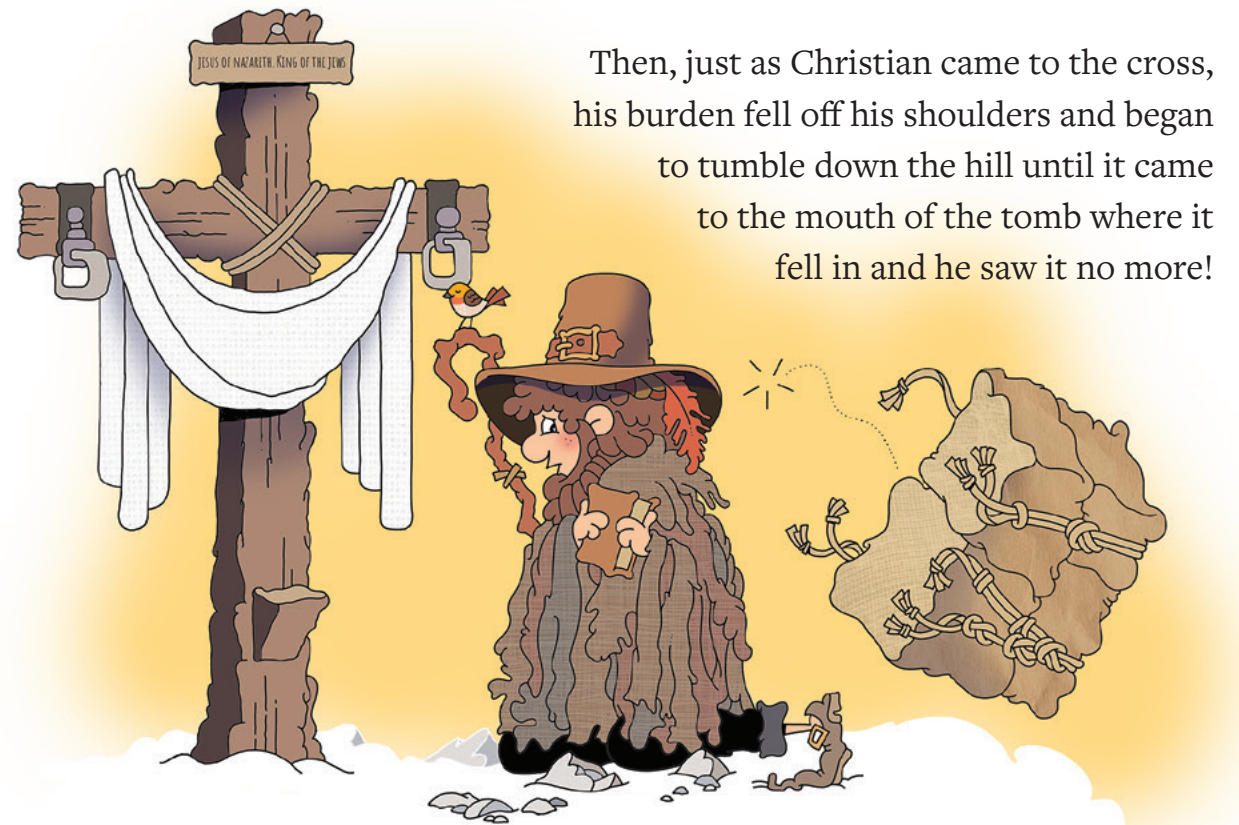
# UPON THAT HILL STOOD A CROSS...

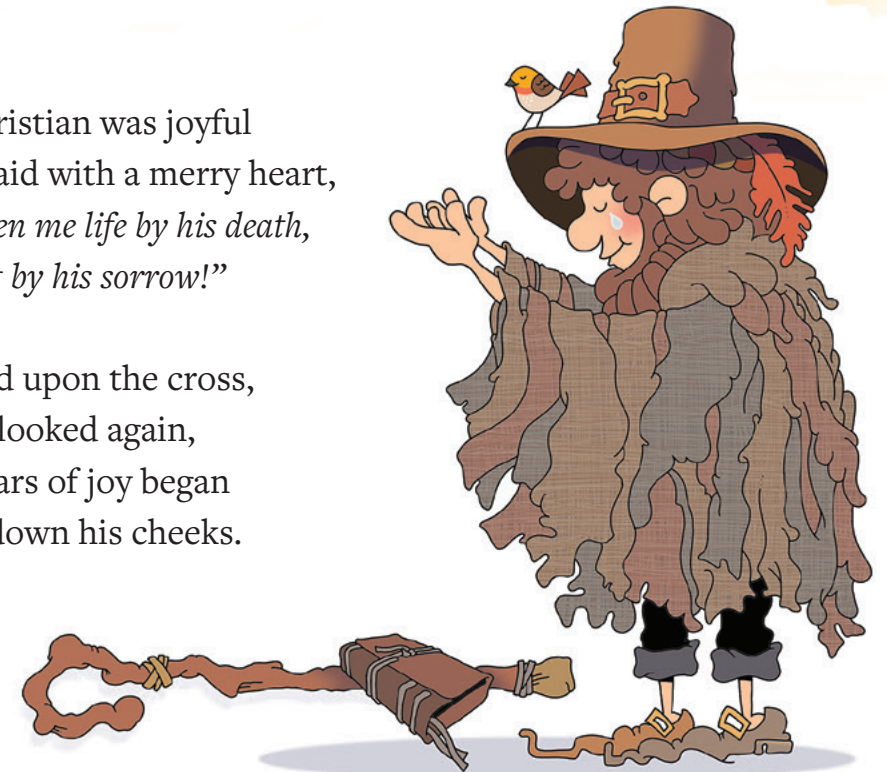
