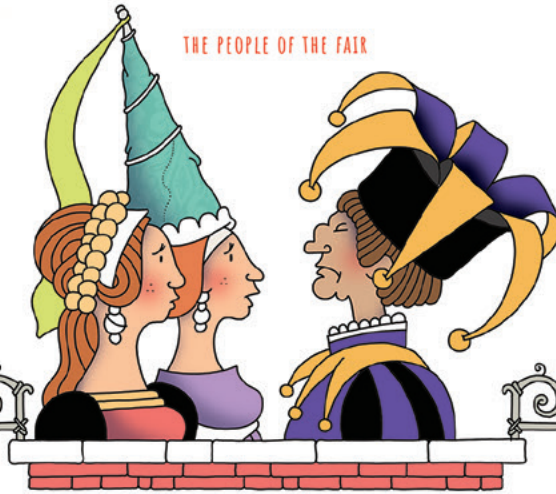
## LORD HATE-GOOD

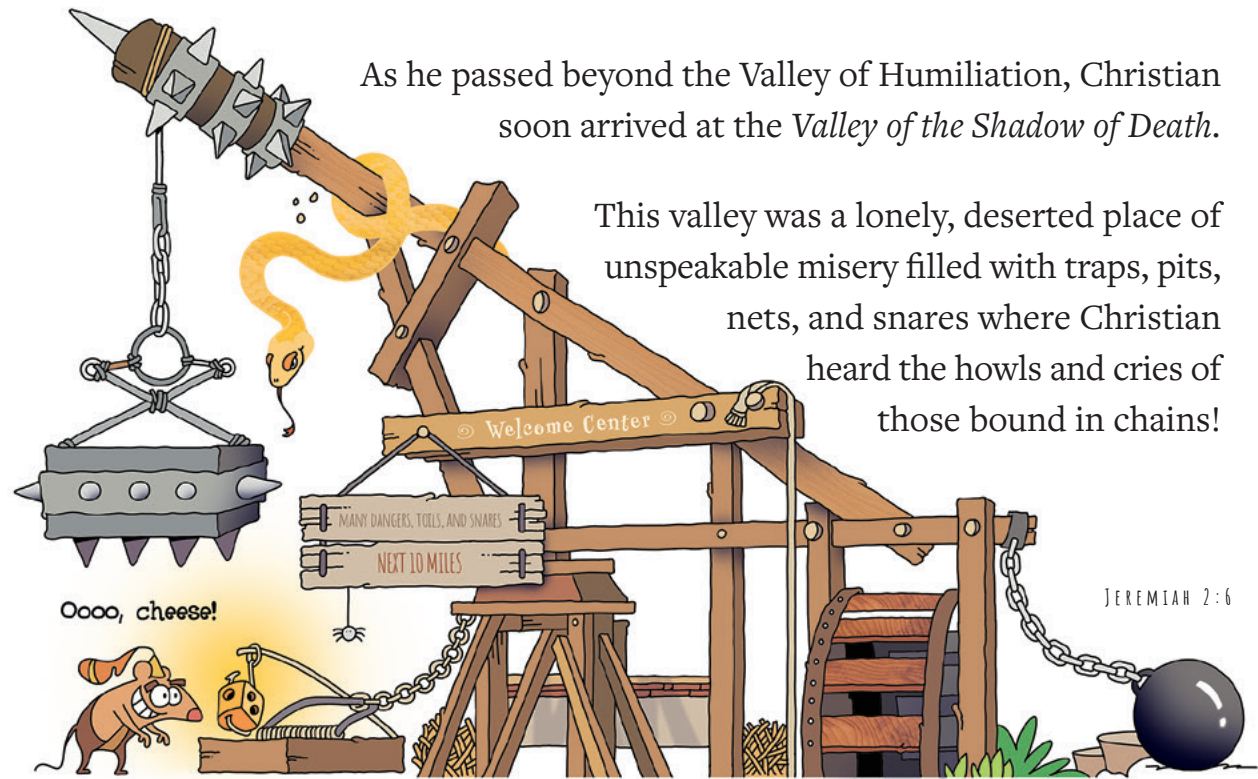

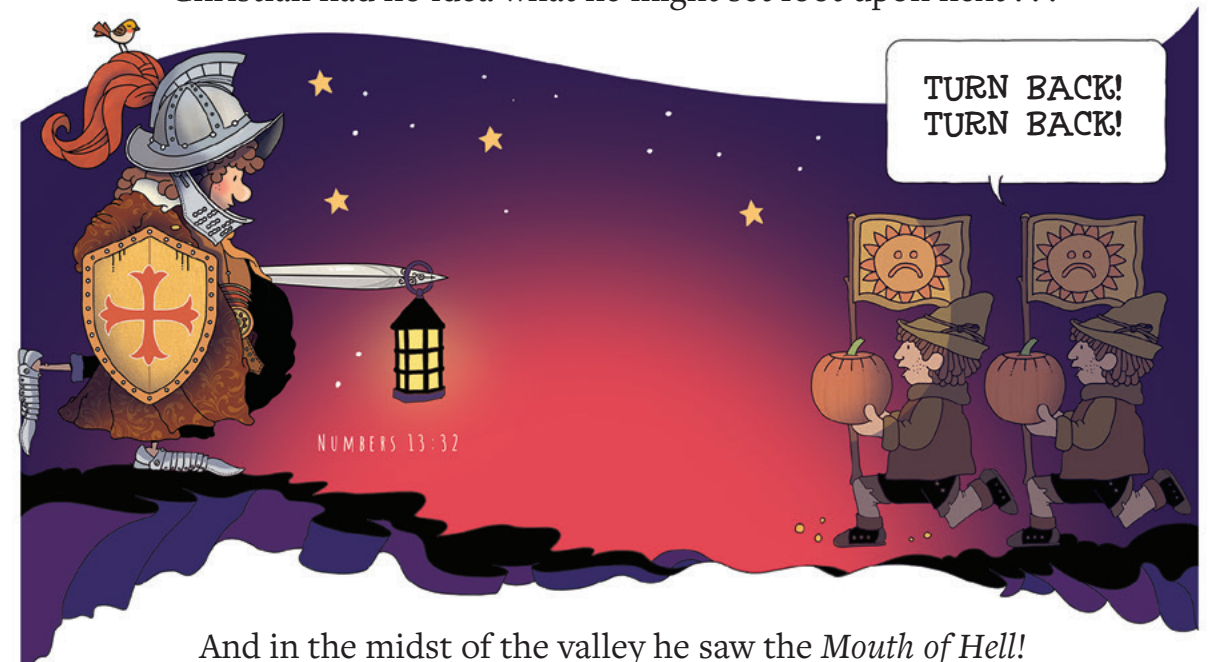
Being refreshed, Christian continued on his journey. But he kept his sword drawn in his hand, fearing he might meet with other enemies along the Narrow Way.



As he passed beyond the Valley of Humiliation, Christian soon arrived at the *Valley of the Shadow of Death*.

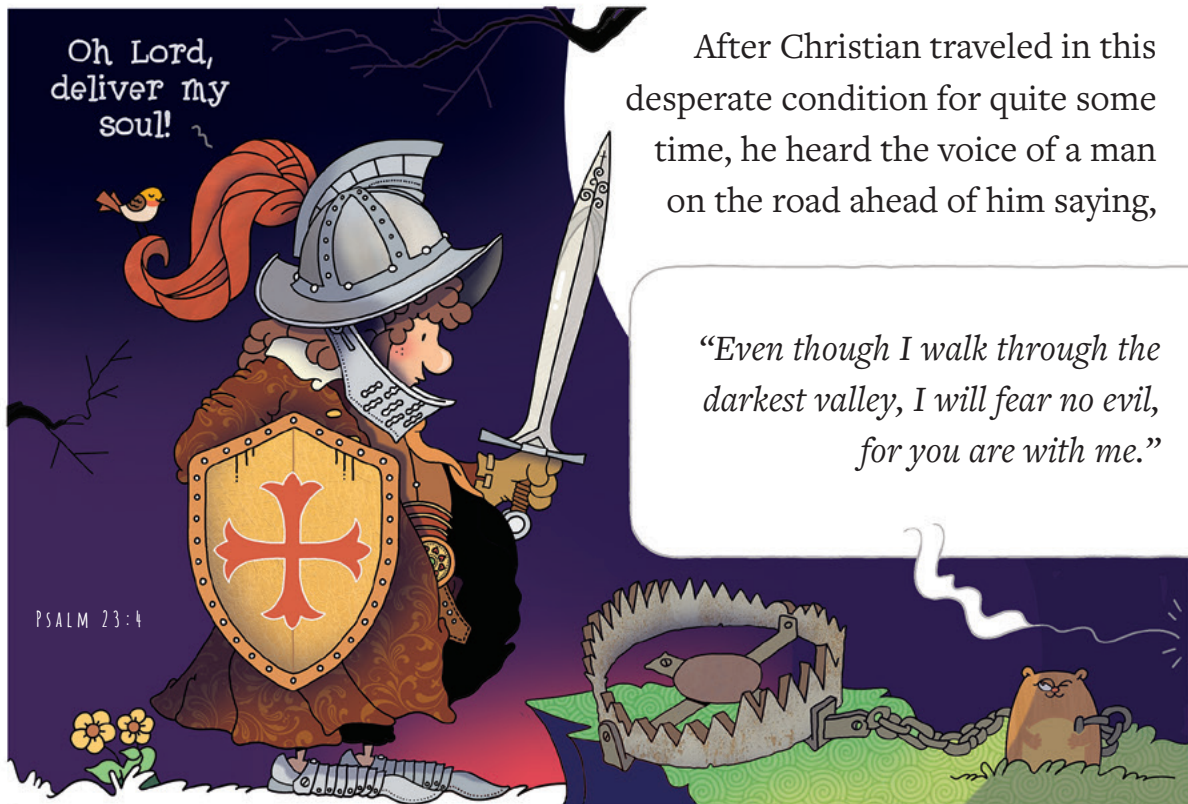
This valley was a lonely, deserted place of unspeakable misery filled with traps, pits, nets, and snares where Christian heard the howls and cries of those bound in chains!

This made Christian glad, for he now realized that someone who feared God was with him in that valley!



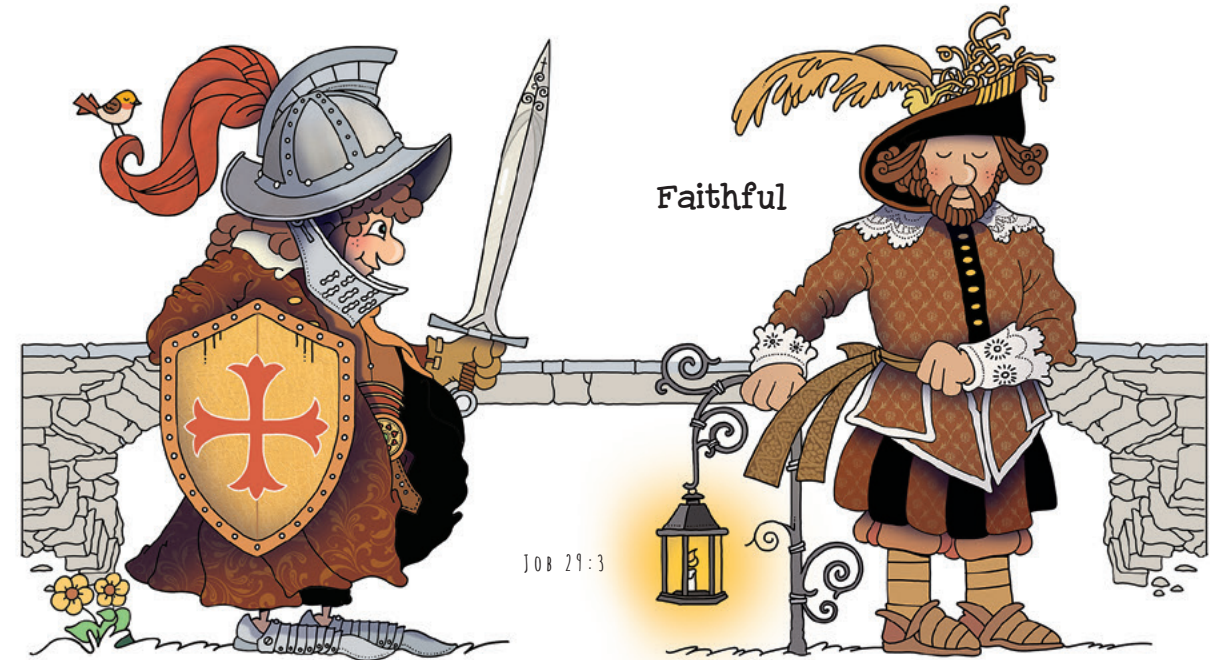
So he traveled on until he came to the top of a little hill where he saw a man named *Faithful* running ahead of him.
